<input type="checkbox"/> Begin the application. Visit the website for a link to the application portal, where you will create an account and complete the application. In the application, you will also select available dates for the applicant interview.	Deadline: Friday, January 12, 2018
<input type="checkbox"/> Request recommendations from the student's current English and math teachers. Students who only have one teacher for their current grade should also ask the teacher from the previous year for a recommendation.	Deadline: Friday, January 19, 2018
<input type="checkbox"/> Request transcripts from the student's present school. We must receive grades from the current semester/trimester as well as grades from the previous school year. You can use our online system to track the progress of paperwork associated with your application, including transcripts and recommendations.	Deadline: Friday, January 26, 2018
<input type="checkbox"/> Applicant interview: After the Admissions Office receives your family's completed application, you will be contacted about an appointment. The interview consists of a conversation between the student and a member of our Admissions Committee. One or both parents also may meet with the interviewer to ask questions about the school or share insights about their child.	Applicant interviews are held in January and February 2018 and are scheduled in December and January. Even if your family submits an application early in the admissions season, the interview confirmation will arrive in December or January.
<input type="checkbox"/> Shadow visit: These visits provide applicants with an opportunity to visit campus on a weekday morning and attend classes with a current Prep student. <i>Please note that these visits are optional and separate from the interview.</i> If you would like to schedule a visit, please contact the Admissions Office in December.
